Jack Woodhams, CEO and Co-founder, Menfulness

Menfulness is a men's social wellbeing group who - through activities and counselling - support and promote improvement in men's lives.

Alison Chorlton is a Lead Nurse for Sexual Health and HIV services across York and North Yorkshire, she has been a non-medical prescriber for nearly 20 years, is a qualified coil and contraceptive implant fitter. Surgical specialisation includes laparoscopic (keyhole) surgery. Ben qualified MBBS at the Royal Free Medical School in 1995. He completed specialist training in London which led to the award of FRCS(Urol) in 2011 (Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons). He has extensive experience in a broad variety of urological conditions gained in leading UK hospitals and has also performed a fellowship in cancer and trauma reconstruction at The Alfred Hospital in Australia. He undertook a research degree at The Institute of Urology in London investigating prostate function.

**Dr Kathy Petersen** is GP Partner in Northumberland, and Strategic Clinical Lead for mental health, learning disability and neurodivergence for North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board.
